So how is your Resurrection Celebration? For forty days and forty nights we prayed, fasted and gave alms from our pocket and the work of our hands. For forty days we died to self. In the midst of these fifty days of Easter, how is your Resurrection celebration going? Or have you settled back to the same old same old.

In the gospel for this Third Sunday of Easter, Jesus makes it clear that the truth of his resurrection lies in the fact that even when his physical presence is gone, his Spirit remains with us. We have a tendency of ~ out of sight, out of mind. Let us not forget our hard work in the desert to get to Easter Mountain. Let us not forget that empty tomb joy we experience as Jesus breathed Spirit on us. By the power of the Spirit we are given an Easter gift to experience empty tomb joy each time we take part in the Breaking of the Bread. Let us celebrate the resurrection with joy and gladness every moment not just on Easter day; remember we are an Easter people and Alleluia is our song.

Speaking of the presence of our Lord in the Breaking of the Bread, did you know that within our Center-City Parishes we have the opportunity to experience the Risen Lord during Eucharistic Adoration, Tuesday through Friday and the first Saturday of every month? Please consult the Liturgical Schedule for details. There are many times that our Lord is alone, can you not spend one hour with Him to rekindle your Easter joy? There is much Easter joy we just need to stop long enough to experience it. May you experience the joy of the Lord this week in a special way.

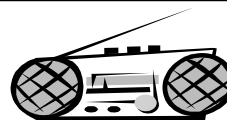
An Opportunity!

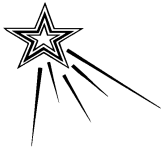
