PRESENTATIONS ON "1978—YEAR OF 3 POPES" ~

Thirty years ago the Catholic Church witnessed the death of Pope Paul VI, the election of Pope John Paul I, 33 short days later his sudden death, and then the shocking election of Pope John Paul II, the first non-Italian pope in 455 years. Fr. Frank Almada, administrator of the Catholic Community in Sharpsburg, is offering three presentations on these Church leaders. All presentations are on Thursdays from 7:30-9:00 p.m. *August 21, Pope Paul VI: Shepherd of Vatican II; September 25, Pope John Paul I: The Smiling Pope; October 23, on Pope John Paul II: Visitor from the East.* These sessions will be held at the John Paul I Pastoral Center, 9th and Clay Streets, Sharpsburg, Sessions are free and open to all.
