### *St. John Vianney, Cure of Ars*

On June 19, 2009, Pope Benedict XVI declared the opening of the “*Year for priests*” and proclaimed St. Jean-Marie Baptiste Vianney, the beloved Cure of Ars, as universal patron of priests, a “true example of a priest at the service of the flock of Christ”.

John was born in France and at the age of 20 began school, but found studying difficult. Still he persevered and was ordained. He became the parish priest of the village of Arsen-Dombes where he spent the rest of his life. He was so renowned as a confessor that hundreds of visitors and pilgrims visited Ars daily. He attracted great crowds for his “little catechisms” ~ short teachings that were simple to understand, filled with imagery drawn from daily life, and infused with faith, common sense and remarkable spiritual insight.

August 4 marks the 150th anniversary of the death of this holy priest known for his simple, direct preaching and his extraordinary ministry of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. When he died he already had the reputation of being a saint. He claimed that our happiness can be found only in prayer.

Through the intercession of St. John Vianney, and during this “*Year for Priests*”, let us be reminded to pray for priests. Each week, beginning this week we will print names of priests ministering in our diocese and who will welcome your prayers. Pray this week for:
