Learning How to Rejoice

“Miss Johnson...” I look up from my desk to see an earnest, anxious student. She is clutching a lopsided array of dog-eared papers and weighty textbooks. “Miss Johnson...” she begins again. Her tired eyes implore me to listen closely. I wait. “My parents are going to kill me. I am failing your course. What do I need to do to pass?”

John the Baptist finds himself in a similar situation in today’s gospel. He is surrounded by an equally anxious flock of students. They too are weary. They carry with them an impressive array of Old Testament wisdom, yet fail to grasp the key. They do not know how to rejoice. They crave rules and regulations and will not rest until they are given something to “do”.

Both John and I are good teachers. We recognize that fear-filled hearts do not hear. Swift intervention is in order. “Whoever has two coats must share...Collect no more than the amount prescribed... Be satisfied with your wages... Hand in an extra assignment.”

Soon Jesus will come. He will have compassion for the fear-filled student. He will tell parables, to calm troubled hearts and use verbs in all of his sentences. Love your God... love your neighbor... love yourself. His listeners will be like grain tossed by a winnowing fork. Soon their hearts will be open, pliable ~ ready to heal and to hear. Soon they will be ready to rejoice.

Congress recently amended the Internal Revenue Code to allow people over 70 and 1/2 to make completely tax free charitable contributions of assets invested in Individual Retirement Accounts (IRAs) The new law benefits IRA owners who are 70 and 1/2 years of age or older at the time of their gift, but only for the tax year ending December 31, 2009.
