### *Getting Past Our Anxieties*

“Protect us from all anxiety ~ and useless worry,” the priest added as he concluded the Lord’s Prayer, *Useless*. The word really struck me.

Like Martha, I can be easily distracted by worries ~ my daily “to-do” list; a serious health issue; an anticipated offer. But Jesus sees my heart too, and knows that, like Martha, when I’m feeling overwhelmed, I’m often unable to pay attention to what is there ~ his love, strength, and guidance. Jesus doesn’t tell Martha that her concerns are not important. But, as he says very tenderly, “Martha, Martha,” Jesus reminds her that Mary has chosen the “better part”, *listening*. When I focus on what seems unfair, or on my fears and anxiety, I gain nothing. But in the midst of these, if I try to be more like Mary, I can discover Jesus’ presence there. I may hear him speak a word of encouragement in the voice of a friend, or the peach of a walk in the sunshine.

“Protect us from all anxiety as we wait in joyful hope for the coming of our Savior...” concludes the prayer. Like Abraham, when I can wholeheartedly welcome even the unexpected, graciously sharing what I have, I too may hear an impossibly wonderful message! New life comes in many ways when we are freed from useless worry ~ greater confidence, stronger hope, and ever deeper joy!

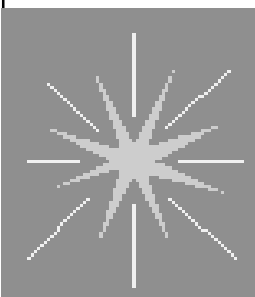

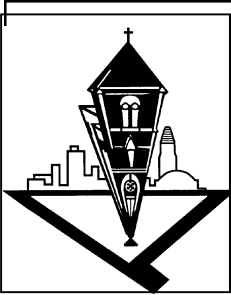

**Countdown to St. Mary of Mercy Church's Diamond Jubilee**

(twelfth in a series)

**"The Need, Again, for a New, Larger Church"**

The Missionary Confraternity of Christian Doctrine (sometimes known as the Mission Confraternity of Catholic Doctrine) grew and expanded while

Father Lawless was pastor, which required the services of more priests. While the number of registered parishioners decreased, the attendance kept increasing. It became impossible to give the faithful that flocked to the church, built in 1893, adequate accommodations. In fact, on Holy Days and the later Masses on Sundays, it was typical to find the church filled, the steps jammed and the street crowded with worshipers. On Sundays, there were five Masses and on Holy Days ten Masses. Sometimes Mass was celebrated in the basement of the old church. The concern was not only being unable to accommodate the people but also the apparent weakness throughout the structure and the house and rectory that was built for one priest but was now housing five. It became evident a new church and rectory had to be built.
