*Notes from the Team Notebook....*

On June 29, 2009 Pope Benedict XVI signed his new encyclical "Caritas in Veritate" (Charity in Truth). Below are some excerpts. The full text can be accessed online at the Holy See's Web site, [www.vatican.va](http://www.vatican.va).

**On Life-** "When society moves toward the denial of suppression of life, it ends up no longer finding the necessary motivation and energy to strive for man's true good. The acceptance of life strengthens moral fiber and makes people capable of mutual help."

**On the Environment-** "The international community has an urgent duty to find institutional means of regulating the exploitation of nonrenewable resources, involving poor countries in the process, in order to plan together for the future."

**On Labor-** "The processes (outsourcing jobs from richer countries to poorer countries) have led to a downsizing of the social security systems as the price to be paid for seeking greater competitive advantage in the global market, with consequent grave danger for the rights of workers, for the fundamental human rights and for the solidarity associated with the traditional forms of the social state."

**On Politics-**When faith is excluded from public discussions or manipulated by the religious fundamentalists, "public life is sapped of its motivation and politics takes on a domineering and aggressive character."
