**YEAR OF ST. PAUL ~ EUCHARISTIC ADORATION****BENEDICTION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT ~ (cont)**

*Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament is a rite in which a priest or a deacon pronounces a blessing over those who are present for Eucharistic adoration. As he gives the blessing, he elevates the monstrance that contains the sacred host. Benediction normally follows a period of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, just prior to its reposition into the Tabernacle. The adoration of Jesus in the Eucharist also leads to greater reverence at Mass, a deeper desire for personal holiness and a stronger sense of union with the parish and the whole church. The early Church has linked Eucharistic devotions to service to the poor and more recently, the practice has led to an increase in vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and religious life. Eucharistic adoration has existed as long as the Church has celebrated the Eucharist.*
