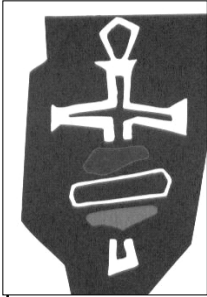

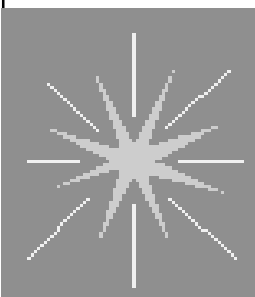

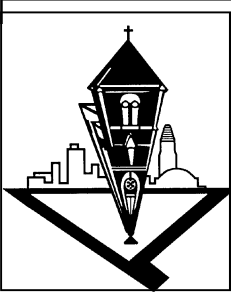

**Countdown to St. Mary of Mercy Church's Diamond Jubilee**

(tenth in a series)

**Monsignor Daniel A Lawless**

Once the streets were widened and the rectory and church moved to accommodate the wider streets, Fr. O'Connor was transferred to St. Peter Parish in McKeesport in October, 1921. He was succeeded by Fr.

Daniel A. Lawless, who became Pastor in October of 1921. Fr. Lawless was one of the best-known priests at St. Mary of Mercy up until this time, and one who served longer than any other to this parish. He stayed at St. Mary of Mercy for 42 years, serving under three Bishops - Bishops Boyle, Dearden and Wright. He was named a domestic prelate with the title of Monsignor by Pope Pius XII 1956.

The church hall is named for Monsignor Lawless.
