This week go outside the box. Don't just say you believe in God ~ live like you do. Don't keep the Good News of Jesus to yourself ~ tell someone about Him. Don't think you have to do everything by your self ~ live in the Holy Spirit and God will do everything for you. Actually assimilating our faith into our lives is easy, we just need to get out of the way.

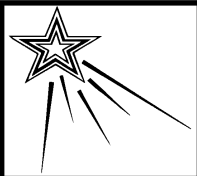
