NEW ASSIGNMENT FOR OUR PRIESTS ~ Effective Monday, July 7, 2008, Fr. Carmen D'Amico will be appointed to Team Ministry at Sr. Benedict the Moor, Epiphany and St. Mary of Mercy Parishes for a term of six (6) years. He, along with Fr. A YEAR IN HONOR OF SAINT PAUL ~ Bishop Zubik writes: "Our Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI, has asked the entire Church to celebrate a year in honor of Saint Paul the apostle on the occasion of the 2000th anniversary of his birth. This year long celebration begins on the solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul on June 29, 2008. The observation has special meaning for the people of Pittsburgh since Saint Paul is our secondary patron. To begin this celebration asking for the intercession of Saint Paul, I am writing to ask that every parish send at least two representatives to the Mass inaugurating the "Year of Saint Paul" on June 29, 2008 at 3:00 p.m. at St. Paul Cathedral."
