***Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ***

This feast, formerly called *Corpus Christi*, developed during the Middle Ages (in the year 1264) at the request of St. Thomas Aquinas who wrote the hymns and prayers for the feast. Its purpose was to emphasize the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. A procession with the Blessed Sacrament in a monstrance was a public display of faith. Processions, incense, flowers, canopy, monstrance! For 800 years people looked at and adored our Lord in the Eucharist, singing about the awesome presence of Christ among us, remembering Holy Thursday, spiritually communing but rarely daring to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord in Holy Communion.

Today we understand once more that the Eucharist is for eating and drinking. The feast of the Body and Blood of Christ calls us to ponder the love of our Savior who came to be with us and to serve us in a most ordinary way, and to ask how we might follow more closely in his footsteps.

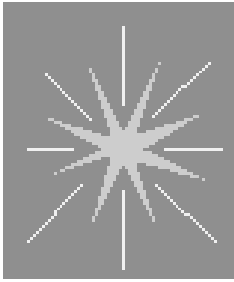

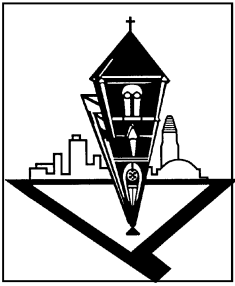

**Countdown to St. Mary of Mercy  
Church's Diamond Jubilee**  
(sixth in a series)

**"Remembering the Chapel  
Of Fort Duquesne"**

Father A.A. Lambing, who had assumed the spiritual duties of the church, following Father Devlin's death in 1873, wanted to perpetuate the memory of the first Mass that was celebrated 100 years prior to the establishment of the first Catholic Church at the Point.

Some history: in 1754 the French soldiers captured the English fort (Pitt) at the junction of the Monongahela and Allegheny Rivers, the known as "the Forks" but now known as "the Point". The French built a new fort and named it after the Marquis du Quesne. On the morning of April 17, 1754, the First Mass was offered in the open air by Father Denis Baron, Chaplain of the French forces. Later a Chapel was build in the fort under the title of "the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin of the Beautiful River". The French realized they could not resist the advancing English troops, under the leadership of General John Forbes, so they burned their French fort and withdrew to Lake Erie. The English took possession and built Fort Pitt.

One hundred years later, in honor of the first Mass, Father Lambing decided to erect a side altar in the "new" church and include a Munich statue of the Mother of God. The blessing took place on September 24, 1878, two years after the church was dedicated. Again, the significance of September 24 ~ the feast of Our Lady of Mercy.
