SOMETHING TO PONDER ~A healthy friendship with God needs the time and attention of prayer. Yet the hectic pace of life can make it hard to find time to pray. Consider the following: Pray the wait ~ pray a decade of the rosary while waiting in traffic or at the doctor's office. Pray the Bible ~ Copy a different passage from the Bible each week and put it in your pocket or on the refrigerator. Try to memorize it and think about its meaning. Pray the sounds ~ Listen to recorded prayers or inspirational music while driving or doing chores at home. Pray the moment ~ Pick a simple phrase to repeat during the day. Pray a Jesus prayer and simply talk to Jesus from your own heart.
