The Oscar winning movie for Best Picture now playing in theaters is "Slum-dog Millionaire." The surprise hit movie is about two brothers who are orphaned in the slums of Mumbai, India. A story of survival, a doing what it takes to live through each and every day kind of movie. Without giving too much away, the two brothers Salim and Jamal take two different paths to prosperity. As the two boys grow up and mature, Salim learns a life of taking what he wants even at the risk of murder and stealing, and Jamal, after a childhood of stealing and scams, learns that love and truth is what matters.

Lent is a time to rededicate ourselves, our time and our energy to doing the work of God ~ living in the Truth, embracing pure Love. As we live our own stories of survival through our baptismal promises, we are called to be people of the Truth, Jesus Christ, the Love of God. 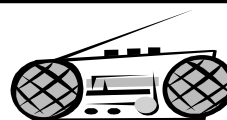

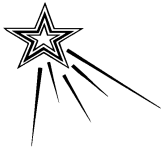
