"The custom of a May altar stems from southern European countries. A report from France in 1842 speaks of Our Lady's altar in May showing off in rich splendor. All of nature awakened to new life in springtime is presented to honor Mary, who is herself "a rose of Sharon, a lily of the valleys" (*Song of Songs* 2,1). This form of devotion was influence and furthered, for example, in *Treatise on True Devotion to Mary* by Louis de Montfort, who, among other things, counted the decoration of Marian altars a chief exercise of Marian devotion." (The Marian Library)

Throughout the month of May we encourage everyone to bring flowers from your garden to adorn the May altars in each of parish churches. Let us honor Mary our Mother throughout this month of May for her willingness to say "Yes" to love and serve her Son, our brother the Lord Jesus the Christ that we may gain courage and strength to go and do the same.

Today is Good Shepherd Sunday, World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Let us pray through the intercession of Mary that the Lord may raise up many more young men and women from within our midst to serve the church as priests, deacons, religious sisters and brothers. We invite all to attend a special **Holy Hour for Vocations 7:00 p.m. May 7<sup>th</sup> at St. Paul Seminary, Crafton.** Come join Bishop David A. Zubik, our Seminarians and people from all over the diocese to storm heaven with prayers for an increase of holy vocations.

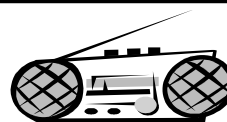
