***We are called to be a “wind of change”***

When Angelo Roncalli became Pope John XXIII, no one expected any changes in the Church. This proved to be a total misreading of how good the Spirit is at surprising God’s people.

The surprise came when good Pope John, moved by the Spirit, called an ecumenical council, the first to take place in almost a century. The Church, he believed, was ripe for nothing less than “a new Pentecost”. The first Christian Pentecost also came as total surprise. It was already a great day for devout Jews to gather in Jerusalem and commemorate the wondrous gift of Torah and covenant on Mount Sinai.

But no one expected a sudden rush of wind to blow down from heaven nor tongues of fire to rest upon a small group of fearful Galileans, making them bold proclaimers of the gospel of Christ.

More than forty years after the completion of Vatican II, many of us still yearn for another new Pentecost to take place in our Church. We feel the need for “a wind of change” so that the gospel of Christ may be more proclaimed to the world with more passion and meaning. We are called to “live by the Spirit” and bear the fruits that can change the face of the world.

Pentecost is in a special way the Baptism of the church which carries out her universal mission starting from the roads of Jerusalem with the miraculous preaching in humanity’s different tongues. In this Baptism of the Holy Spirit the personal and community dimension, the “I” of the disciples and the “we” of the Church, are inseparable. The Holy Spirit consecrates the person and at the same time makes him or her a living member of the Mystical Body of Christ, sharing in the mission of witnessing to His love. And this takes place through the Sacraments of Christian initiation: Baptism and Confirmation.

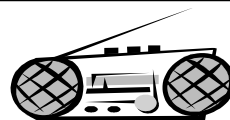
