Today's gospel anticipates dramatic events of the end-times, when after a time of suffering, the world as we know it will pass away. When I consider some of our global relationships and the state of our planet, I see much suffering. Some of us are wealthy while many more are very poor. Some have power and other have no voice. The earth is damaged by pollution and over-consumption. I sometimes wonder if we will every fully live out God's call to love our neighbors and to be good stewards of creation.

Instead of a message of doom, however, this gospel reading offers hope. As we wait in hope for the fulfillment of the kingdom of God in Christ's return in glory, let us give thanks for the living Word of God empowering us to respect creation and to build a more just, loving and peaceful world.
