Two widows show us how to give

In today's readings we encounter two widows who, though among the poorest, gave all they had to live on. We don't know what became of them, but they had great trust to be able to share despite their uncertain future.

Compassion and care for others surely prompt our own giving, although seldom is such radical generosity asked. Perhaps, like the scribes, our giving may sometimes be tinged with a need for recognition or affirmation. Contributing to charitable works is important, but we can also be generous in sharing ourselves in simple ways. Smiling and seeking eye contact when saying "thank you", giving a compliment, or offering "the peace of Christ."

Sometimes, like the widow of Zarephath, we may feel we have little personal strength or resources to share, especially when we experience stress or hardship. But, as Elijah reassured her, "Do not be afraid". God will reward our giving with unstinting bounty.

When diagnosed with a serious illness, I took the unlikely step of beginning a gratitude journal. It helped me to see and receive the simple gifts of each day ~ birds singing, a pot of soup from a friend. Gradually, fear faded and trust grew, as did an ability to reach out to others.

With the psalmist, we can affirm, "The Lord lifts up those who are bowed down."

Wednesday Eucharistic Adoration

Due to a lack of attendance we find it necessary to discontinue Adoration at Epiphany on Wednesday mornings **only**. Church liturgical norms require that at the very least, one person is present in the church during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. If you recall this is the same reason why daily adoration was discontinued one year ago. Various suggested options are being looked at to continue to avail adoration to the faithful, including possibly one hour before daily Mass or following, on particular days of the week. We thank those who continue to attend adoration on Friday afternoons. We ask all to spread the word that Eucharistic Adoration is available three days a week in the city: Tuesday morning and Thursday afternoons at St. Mary's and Friday afternoons at Epiphany.

Tax-Free Gifts from IRAs

In most years, if you are over the age of 70 1/2, you must take a required minimum distribution from your IRA. In 2009, you may instruct your IRA custodian to withhold the normal required distribution. As usual, the amount of any distribution is taxed as ordinary income. However, federal legislation enacted on October 3, 2008 extends the opportunity for you, for the remainder of 2009, to make a direct distribution from your IRA to a qualified charity, such as one of our parishes, or our catholic school. Such distributions, up to \$100,000, are not subject to income tax.
