**God Gathers Us Today**

Almost a year ago, in the responsorial psalm of the first Sunday of Advent, we cried out to God to come and save us. In today's readings we proclaim the great God who has kept the promise to do so. Jeremiah reminds us of God's promise in the first reading, and Jesus' cure of Bartimaeus in the gospel is a sign that God, in Jesus, is indeed doing great things among the people.

In the words of Jeremiah, God promises to gather the covenant people and bring them home, even the blind and lame. In the gospel Jesus does just that. Jesus cures Bartimaeus of his blindness and frees him to go his own way. But the gospel tells us that instead, Bartimaeus followed Jesus on his way. Jesus is indeed gathering the people of God.

At today's celebration of the Eucharist, this work of Jesus continues. Look around. Who is present? If we look carefully we will see people from the farthest parts of the earth gathered into this one assembly. We see people of all ages and abilities. We have come through the waters of baptism to feast at the Lord's table. Together we cry out for our needs and the needs of the world and are consoled at the table of God's Word. On our lips are songs of joy, because God has done great things for us, each and every one.
