*We discover Jesus in surprising places*

We are familiar with the names of the rich and famous, leaders of nations and sports stars. Thanks to the media, we know how these people look, act, and live. But beyond the superficial, do we really know who they are?

It can be the same with our Christian faith. "I believe in God". "I follow the ten commandments". "I keep the doctrines and rules of the Church". But Jesus asks Peter, "Who do you say that I am?" This question follows us on our life journey, a quest to come to terms with the identity of Jesus. Who is Jesus for me? Where do I find him?

The New Testament gives us a glimpse into Jesus' identity. The answer to Saul's outrage against Christians is "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting" (Acts 9). In the final judgment, Jesus says, "What you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me" (Mt. 25). Jesus identifies himself with the persecuted and the poor. He identifies with the hungry, thirsty, naked and captive because he is good news to them.

Jesus is known through the gospels and in the sacramental presence of the Eucharist. We find him in the Body of Christ, the body of the poor, and those who struggle for justice. At Eucharist, we can ask ourselves, "Who do we say we are?"

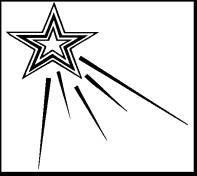
