*Grasping the Challenge of Selflessness*

Few of Jesus' statements are as puzzling as this one: "Whoever wishes to be first must be last of all and servant of all". It ran against the grain in his day as much as it does today. Is it not a recipe for poor self-esteem? For being a perpetual doormat? For being exploited by everyone?

This statement invites us into God's life in a particular way. The early Christian hymn recorded in the letter to the Philippians talks about how Jesus emptied himself and became obedient to death on the cross. In response, God exalted him. The hymn describes the dynamic that is at the heart of life in the Trinity: Each person of God is constantly pouring out the divine self in love and service to the other persons. Each person is constantly welcoming the other, ceding their place to the other, making room.

When we were baptized, we were incorporated into this self-emptying life of love that is the Trinity. We're already part of that dynamic. But it requires a radical un-selfing on our part that only makes sense in a religious world in which those who lose their life will find it.

What makes this not just tolerable, but life-giving, is that every one of us is called to this un-selfing. Just as the persons of the Trinity, we who live in God are called to give our all on this path to glory.

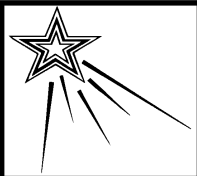
